
Module 5 - Instructions on playing "Jeopardy"



- 1. The participants are organized into six groups with an equal number of members.
- 2. The groups are named after social protection guarantees, namely "Health", "Children", "Working age", "Elderly", "Maternity", and "HIV".
- 3. There are four rounds, each corresponding to a question.
- 4. The group chooses a number from the board (slide 4 of the presentation) and has to answer the question of that number.
- 5. The group consults among themselves and selects the correct answer, within a time limit of 45 seconds.
- 6. The group gets ten points for every correct answer and loses five points for every incorrect answer.
- 7. There are two 'Jackpot' questions where the groups have the chance of earning an extra ten points for every correct answer. Hence, for a correct answer, the group earns 20 points. For a wrong answer, they still lose five points.
- 8. There is a 'Joker' question, wherein the group gets ten points without answering a question.
- 9. The points earned by each group are converted into budget money according to the conversion table on the following page.
- 10. This money is recorded in the budget table.
- 11. The budget money is used by groups to design social protection provisions for their respective guarantees.
